

## Formentera del Segura

The old part of Formentera del Segura is located beside the Rio Segura and forms part of the walking and cycling route along the river. Situated on an 'island' in the middle of the river, and only open at certain times, is the El Molino Natural Park with its picnic tables, seasonal barbecues, large stage area and an 18th century water powered floor mill. The church and town hall form one side of the quaint central square which is dominated by the large and beautifully shaped trees. Formentera also has a summer only outside municipal swimming pool, a small street market every Monday morning with less than a dozen stalls and a selection of bars, cafes and shops.

Turn right towards the mountain for Algorfa, Benejuzar and Orihuela or turn left towards the coast for Rojales and Guardamar Marina. There are paths on both banks of the river and a footbridge over the river connecting both sides at the Rojales end of Formentera village. Rojales is only a couple of kilometres away and the river runs straight through the middle of the village, walk there along one bank and after a coffee stop walk back along the other bank using the footbridge to cross the river.
